



BROKEN CRAYONS?

MAKE MULTI-COLOR CRAYON MOLDS!

STEP 1:

Preheat the oven to 250 degrees.

STEP 2:

Peel the paper off the crayons and break them into small pieces.

Step 3:

Have the kids arrange the crayons in a muffin tin. Choose one color or use a fun combination of colors.



Step 4:

Place the tin in the oven for about 20 minutes or until all the crayons are melted. Cool for about 45-60 minutes.

Step 5:

After they cool, pop them out of the tin. They should come out easily, if not put them in freezer for about 15 minutes and they should pop right out.
